

DIRECTUR'S NATES

Journey (noun): An act of traveling from one place to another.

This musical is a journey in many senses of the word. In 2+ hours of performance, it travels from Kansas to Oz and back, and it traveled from page to stage in our three-month production process. Figuratively, a journey should leave its travelers changed, even if they end up in the same literal place they began (whether Kansas or Hammond's theatre). Travelers should have a new perspective on their lives, as well. Perhaps it's an appreciation for the warmth of home, a renewed commitment to important people in their lives, or the confidence to know that they can affect change in the world.

The story is a classic one, first told in L. Frank Baum's novel *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* (1900) and then in the movie musical adaptation starring Judy Garland (1939). *The Wiz* debuted on Broadway in 1978 with an all-black cast, combining soulful music with a powerful belief of the transformative power of community. It was a hit, running for 1,600+ performances and winning 7 TONY awards. Its relevance today is clear, as the characters search for their purpose and fight to free their lives from fear and deception. Yet, in all this, they maintain an underlying hope and joy.

It has been my great joy to direct this production. I am proud of the work that our immensely talented group has poured into this epic show. It features the largest musical cast in my time here, our first time performing over two weekends, and many double-cast leading roles. We're all here because we think this story, these songs, and these characters deserve to be shared, discussed, and celebrated. Thank you for your patronage and for joining us on this journey.


